

Did You Know?


About 180 million workers will pay Social Security taxes in 2021.





About 93 percent of all workers are covered or eligible under Social Security.

Did You Know?



As of December 2020, 46.3 million retired workers were receiving \$71.5 billion dollars in Social Security benefits per month.



At the same time, 3.0 million dependents of retired workers were receiving \$2.4 billion dollars in monthly Social Security benefits.




Social Security in the Future

- The two Social Security trust funds Old-Age and Survivors Insurance (OASI) and Disability Insurance (DI) will be able to pay all benefits in full and on time until 2034.
- The trust funds have reached the brink of asset reserve depletion in the past, but Congress made substantial modifications to avoid this.
- If Congress does not act before 2034, the trust funds will still be able to pay 76 percent of each benefit due.







SSI provides critical financial help to aged, blind, and disabled people who have limited income and resources. Learn if the person you are helping qualifies and help them apply.

Apply for Social Security Disability Insurance Benefits (SSDI)

The SSDI program pays disability benefits to you and certain family members who meet our definition of disability if you worked long enough – and recently enough – under Social Security. It's important to be prepared before filing an application for

Welcome to the Benefit Eligibility Screening Tool (BEST)

BEST helps you find out if you could get benefits that Social Security administers. Based on your answers to questions, this tool will list benefits for which you might be eligible and tell you more information about how to qualify and apply.

BEST is NOT an application for benefits and:

- > does not know, or ask for, your name or Social Security number.
- > does not access your personal Social Security records.
- will not give you an estimate of benefit amounts.

BEST will NOT screen for help with Medicare prescription drug plan costs. If you have Medicare, you might be eligible for this program.
