#### EPA's EJ Grants Program

- 1) EJ Small Grants support and empower communities working on solutions to local environmental and public health issues.
- 2) EJ Collaborative Problem-Solving (CPS)
  Cooperative Agreements support communitybased organizations in building collaborative
  partnerships to help them understand and address
  environmental and public health concerns in their
  communities.
- Agreements (SEJCA) provides funding to agencies to support and/or create model activities that lead to measurable environmental or public health results in communities disproportionately burdened by environmental harms and risks.

Administrative Costs

**\$2.15 million** will build community capacity to address air and water issues in underserved communities through specialized technical assistance.

**\$1.6** million for a grant to support efforts by tribes to engage their community members on priority EJ water and air quality issues.

**\$720k** will be used to enhance the development of EJSCREEN, the EJ analysis tool and support related resources.

**\$700k** is allocated for a climate protection program to advance data analytics work in the Office of Air.

**\$500k** will support new methods of outreach and support for critical EJ issues in the oil and gas sector.

**\$1 million** will be used for administrative costs (2% of funds).
