WHAT

The Sacramento County Office of Education (SCOE) and the American River Parkway Foundation are offering an **Outdoor Environmental Education Program** tied to the Next Generation Science Standards. Students will be immersed in a hands-on, STEM education experience with expert outdoor instruction.

The program consists of a half-day camp along the American River where students will focus on many of the following topics, depending on need and/or season:

- ▶ History of the American River Parkway
- ▶ Engineering Design
- ▶ Open Grassland Environments/Habitats
- ▶ Macroinvertebrates (aquatic insects)
- ▶ Human Impact

WHEN

- ▶ Hours are 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM (rain* or shine).
* rain protection provided for students as needed

DETAILS

- ▶ \$600.00 per camp
 - ◆ Fees will be waived for Title I schools and for special circumstances (with prior approval).
 - ◆ If seeking funding, consider school site council funds. Keep in mind that school site councils may view a “curricular activity” as a higher priority than a “field trip.”
- ▶ School/district/agency must provide transportation and chaperones to and from park.
- ▶ Includes all materials, instruction, bottled water, and snack for each student.
- ▶ Students are encouraged to bring lunches and eat on-site in a beautiful outdoor setting at the conclusion of the activities.
